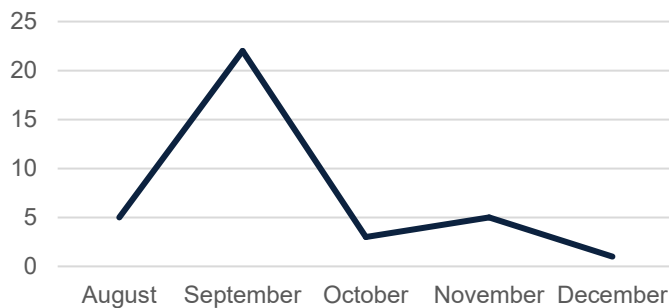

Outreach Efforts

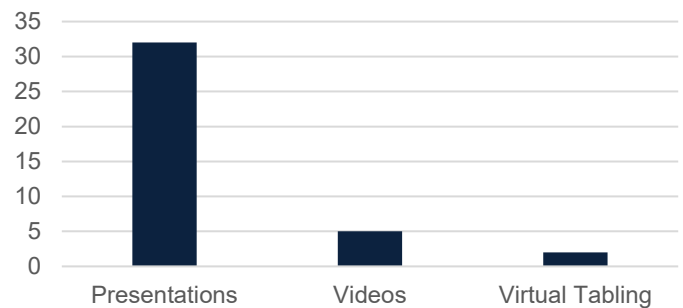
36 outreach efforts were facilitated during the fall 2020 semester
